**JOINT MOTION FOR DISMISSAL OF  
APPEAL AND CROSS-APPEAL**

Appellants/cross-appellees the Internal Revenue Service, U.S. Department of the Treasury, and United States of America (collectively, “the Government”) and appellee/cross-appellant CIC Services, LLC (“CIC Services”), respectfully move this Court for voluntary dismissal of the Government’s appeal and CIC Services’ cross-appeal in the above-captioned cases. In support of this motion, the parties state as follows:

1. These appeals arise from a judgment entered by the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Tennessee. On January 29, 2022, the Government filed a notice of appeal from the District Court’s judgment, which was docketed in this Court at No. 22-

5666. On August 1 and August 2, 2022, CIC Services filed notices of cross-appeal, which were docketed in this Court at No. 22-5667.

2. The Solicitor General has decided that the appeal taken by the Government will not be prosecuted.

3. CIC Services has decided that it will not prosecute its cross-appeal.

4. This case should be remanded to the District Court for resolution of all appropriate post-judgment matters.

WHEREFORE, the Government and CIC Services respectfully request that their appeals from the judgment of the District Court be dismissed with prejudice, each party to bear its own costs related to the above-captioned appeals.
